Payment of Dinners, Breakfast and After School clubs

Please pay in advance for dinners by either paying direct to Parentmail2 (32p transaction charge per child) or putting cash/cheque into the school office.

Childcare should be paid for in advance or promptly. Charges are applied a week in arrears, Breakfast Club usually on a Monday and After School Club on a Wednesday.

If your account falls into arrears you will be sent an automatic reminder from Parentmail2. If you fail to put funds into your account we will unfortunately have to suspend facilities until the arrears are paid off. Thank you.
